



Tracheostomy Educational Opportunities

A working party, coordinated by TRACS WA, and involving multiple health and disability services, has been meeting for about 18 months to provide support to staff involved with the ongoing management of a person with a tracheostomy in non-tertiary services. One aspect of the project has been to align education about tracheostomy management. Tracheostomy training is provided regularly by experienced clinicians at RPH, SCGH and FSH. The table below outlines available training from now until the end of 2019. Clinicians from outside WA health are welcome to attend. There may be a cost associated with some training. You can attend the FSH toolbox sessions by VC, but you must book in advance for telehealth arrangements to be made. See contact details for each service below.
